




Student Feedback - B. COM Programme

No. of students participating – B. COM (50) = Total 50






Student Feedback - B.Sc. Biology

No. of students participating - B.Sc. Biology (84) = Total students 84






Student Feedback - M.A. History

No. of students participating – M.A. History (25) = Total students 25






Student Feedback - M.A. Hindi

No. of students participating – M.A. Hindi (43) = Total students 43






Student Feedback - M.A. Political Science

No. of students participating - M.A. Political Science (40) = Total students 40






Student Feedback - P.G.D.C.A






Alumni Feedback (Mean Score)





The matter is informed to the higher authority for improvement. So, problem will no longer continue in future and it will be helpful to teachers.

They do not come even if called or invited. We are working on it very hardly.
